

**1984 Noble One Botrytis Semillon**

**Region: Riverina, NSW**



**Tasting Note:** Soft, complex botrytis and stone fruit aroma with a touch of butterscotch lead into a lightly structured, sweet - honeyed palate with a creamy mouthfeel. Slight acidity resulting in a dry finish with a long, sweet aftertaste.

**Food Recommendation:** Try with a light, fruity apple tart.

**Wine Analysis:** Alcohol : 13.6 %  
Residual Sugar: 121.0 g/L  
pH : 3.4  
Total Acid : 9.15 g/L

**Winemaker's Comments:** Once again, perfect conditions, heavily botrytised grapes were picked in late April at 24 Baume.
