

1985 Noble One Botrytis Semillon

Region: Riverina, NSW



Tasting Note: A well developed nose showing aromas of apricot with a touch of dusty oak. Rich sweet apricot flavours on the palate with slight acidity resulting in a dry finish with a long, sweet aftertaste. An outstandingly good dessert wine showing dry apricot flavours on the finish.

Food Recommendation: Try with a ricotta pudding and honey figs.

Wine Analysis: Alcohol : 13.4 %
Residual Sugar: 125.0 g/L
pH : 3.45
Total Acid : 10.62 g/L

Winemaker's Comments: Very dry year resulted in generally high Baume. The botrytis infection was good and the grapes were picked between 23 and 27 Baume.
